El Paso USBC Annual Youth Championship 2024-25

- 1. This tournament is certified by USBC and is open to all current El Paso USBC Youth or Special Olympics bowlers. Bowlers must be in good standings. All current 2024-25 Playing Rules and Regulations of USBC will govern this tournament. All protests must be made in writing and submitted to El Paso USBC.
- 2. This is a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 100% of 220 which means whoever bowls the most over their average will win. Example: A 105 average will get 115 pins a game HDCP. A 175 average will get 45 pins a game HDCP.
- 3. **Entering Average** will be based on the highest average of the following:
 - A. Entrant will use their highest 2023-24 USBC verifiable average, including summer, with a minimum of 21 games. However, if an entrant has a current average of 21 games or more that is 10 pin or higher than the previous season's average, the current average will be used.
 - B. If an entrant does not qualify under (A) then the highest average listed on BOWL.COM for the current season with a minimum of 21 games will be used.
 - C. If an entrant does not qualify under (A) or (B) then the highest current verifiable average with a minimum of 21 games as of January 11, 2025. Entrants must bring average verification to the tournament (e.g. league standing sheet closest to January 11, 2025). If an entrant does not bring average verification prior to participating in the tournament, then they will use (D).
 - D. If an entrant cannot qualify under (A), (B), or (C) they may enter the tournament and will be given an average of 220. USBC RULE 319b (Assigned Averages).
- 4. This tournament is an **AWARD** and **SCHOLARSHIP** tournament. All scholarships will be Smart administered. Pay out will be 3 places in each division (Team, Singles, All Events) and 1st place Boy and Girl City Champs.
- 5. Tournament divisions are based on entry counts and averages with Youth Committee approval.
- 6. **Entry fee** for each event is \$18.00 (\$5.45 Awards fee, \$11.55 Linage, and \$1.00 Expense fees). There is an optional All-Events fee of \$2.00.
- 7. League Coordinator must sign the entry form verifying averages. League standing sheets must accompany the entries and have bowler's first and last names and the bowler's current average dated on or around January 11, 2025.
- 8. **CHECK-IN:** Check-in will be 60 minutes prior to squad start time. League Coordinators will have their teams ready to bowl and report to their lanes no later than 30 minutes prior to squad time. League Coordinator who did not submit a fully/properly completed entry form or require changes must report to Check-in no later than one (1) hour prior to squad start time. **Walk-ins or late arrivals** will be accepted no less than one (1) hour prior to squad start time. Acceptance is dependent upon available spots.
- 9. Bowlers may enter as many Team events as they desire but only once in the Singles event. No two bowlers may bowl the team event together on the same team more than 1 time. The highest score is only counted for awards in an event.
- 10. Line up on the entry form will be the official line up and will not be changed except for substitutions. Substitutions will take the place of the regular bowler in the line up in the event of absenteeism. USBC RULE 322b (Absentee/Vacancy) shall apply. Once a substitute has replaced a bowler, that substitute will stay in the lineup for the series.
- 11. There will be no use of tobacco products or alcoholic beverages by any youth member or spectator on or behind tournament lanes occupied by a youth member (bowler).
- 12. Only bowlers participating in that shift, tournament staff (displaying proper RVP certification), and League Coordinator are allowed in the settee area.
- 13. **Dress Code**: Clothing must be in good repair and cannot be offensive. Shirts must have at least quarter length sleeves. Pants, jeans, capris, shorts, and skirts are permitted. Hem length cannot be any shorter than fingertips when arms held straight to sides. No headwear is permitted. Exceptions to this rule can only be approved by the Tournament Director and must be requested in writing and approved no later than 2 hours prior to the start of the competition. **League**Coordinators are responsible to make sure their bowlers adhere to the dress code prior to checking in.
- 14. **Bowling ball give away:** EPUSBC is donating 2 bowling balls including basic drilling/grips (removable thumbs, etc. not included) to be raffled off at the end of the tournament. All bowlers entering the team event will be automatically entered into the raffle. Multiple entries are allowed but you can only win once. Ball winners will have their choice of any ball, and the ball will be obtained through either DSL or BEP Pro shops.
- 15. Proper conduct is expected (**RULE 17d Youth Conduct**). Tournament Management has the authority to disqualify any bowler for not following proper conduct.
